**BLEASDALE GPS TRAIL 9.3 kms (5.8 miles) HEIGHT GAIN 170 m (558 feet)  
START / FINISH BLEASDALE VILLAGE HALL SD 57356 45335  
GRADE EASY**

Enter or download the grid references into your GPS,  
Locate them on the map (OS Explorer OL41) use them as a route or use as GOTOs.  
When you get near the locations start looking around for the  
answers to the questions marked in **BLUE** and enjoy a great day out in Bowland.

No GPS - just plot your route on your map using the grid references and off you go.

Remember your GPS will give you a straight line bearing to your destination; you will need to refer to your map to ensure you use public rights of way. You do not need to climb any walls or gates.
